

Construction of a new fence around the Town of Eagle's designated off-leash dog area will begin the week of April 13th.

This project is an important step in protecting nearby wildlife habitat and sensitive natural resources, including Abrams Creek, while continuing to provide a dedicated space for off-leash recreation. This area is commonly used by elk and deer, and separating dogs from wildlife will help reduce stress and disturbance while improving safety for both pets and animals.

The fence will enclose over 3 acres and incorporate the full extent of the existing area.

Construction Timeline:

Work is expected to begin the week of April 13 and will take approximately 1–2 weeks to complete.

During this time, please:

- Give construction crews plenty of space to work safely
- Expect temporary disruptions in access
- Consider using alternative areas to exercise your dog

Reminder:

This is currently the *only* area on Town of Eagle property where dogs are permitted off-leash.

We appreciate your patience as we complete this improvement and continue working to balance recreation with resource protection.
